The CRRSA Act, which establishes and funds the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF II), directs institutions of higher education to use funds received under Section 314(a)(1), (a)(4) HEERF II to provide emergency financial aid grants to students for emergency costs that arise due to coronavirus.

To qualify for HEERF II emergency grants, students must meet the following criteria:

1. A curriculum student must be currently enrolled in a qualified program.
