



## Higher Education Emergency Relief Funds (HEERF) Request Form

The CARES Act, which establishes and funds the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF), directs institutions of higher education to use funds received under Sections 18004(a)(1) and 18004(c) of the CARES Act to provide emergency financial aid grants to students for expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to coronavirus.

To qualify for CARES Act emergency grants, students must meet the following criteria:

1. A curriculum (CU) student must have been enrolled in at least one seated curriculum class as of March 13, 2020 for the spring 2020 semester **OR** enrolled in the Fall 2020 Semester.
2. A curriculum (CU) student must submit the 19-20 (For Spring) or the 20-21 (For Fall) Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and be deemed TIV eligible as defined by Sec. 484 of the HEA.
