**\*\*IRS Tax Return Transcript (IRSTRT):** If the student or parent is unable to import the 2022 tax returns to FAFSA on the Web, the student will submit to the school a **2022 IRS Tax** <u>RETURN</u> **Transcript**. The transcript may be obtained online at <u>www.irs.gov</u>, on the IRS homepage, click "Get your Tax Record." Click either "Get Online Transcript or Get Transcript by Mail" or by calling 1.800.908.9946.

In most cases, for electronic tax return filers, 2022 IRS income tax return information is available within 2–3 weeks after the return has been accepted by the IRS. Generally, paper filers' tax return information is available within 6-8 weeks after the return has been received by the IRS. If you need more information, contact the FAO.
