REPORTING SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY



How do you determine who is a suspicious person?

- A suspicious person is anyone who acts in a manner not usual for a law-abiding citizen.
- Someone who looks lost, confused, disoriented.
- Someone who looks homeless or mentally disturbed.

If someone approaches you, or you see someone acting in a manner that you feel is unusual, remain at a safe distance and contact Campus Security immediately.

What do you say to Campus Security?

- Be as descriptive as possible:
- Body Description:Race, Sex, Hair, Tattoos, Scars, etc.
- Physical Description: Color and type of clothing, shoes, hairstyle, glasses, hat, etc.
- Weapons: Mention if you notice a weapon or possibility of weapon.
- Direction/Method of Travel
